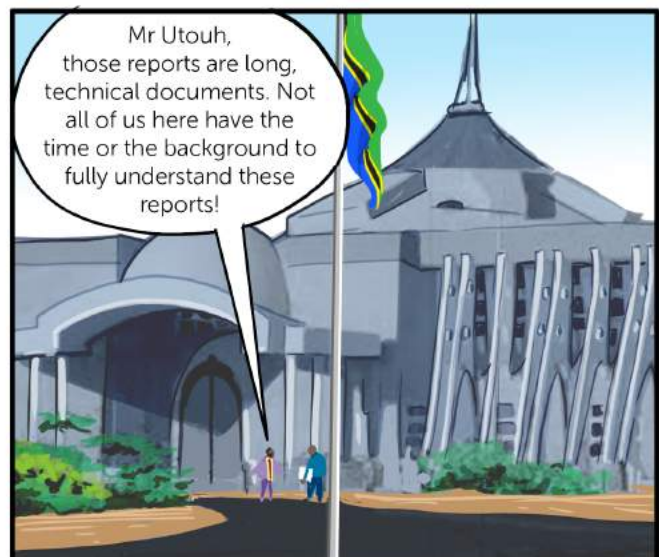


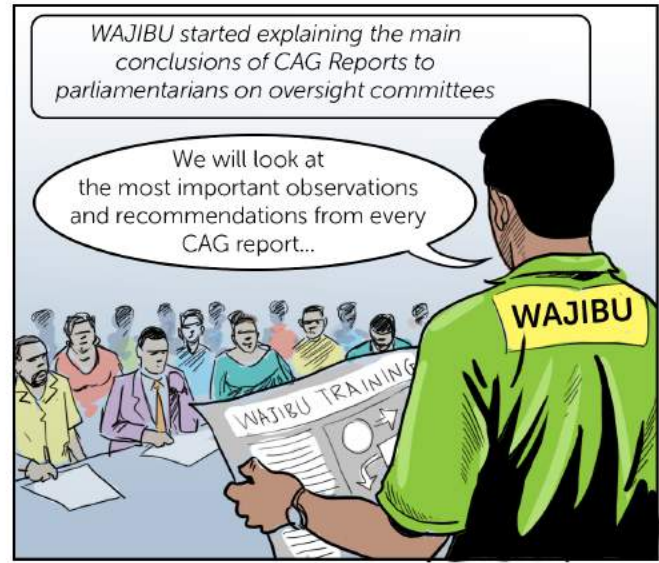
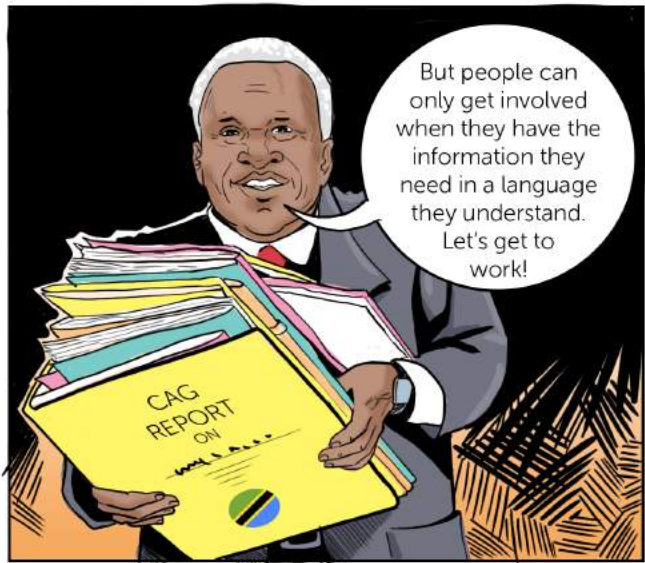
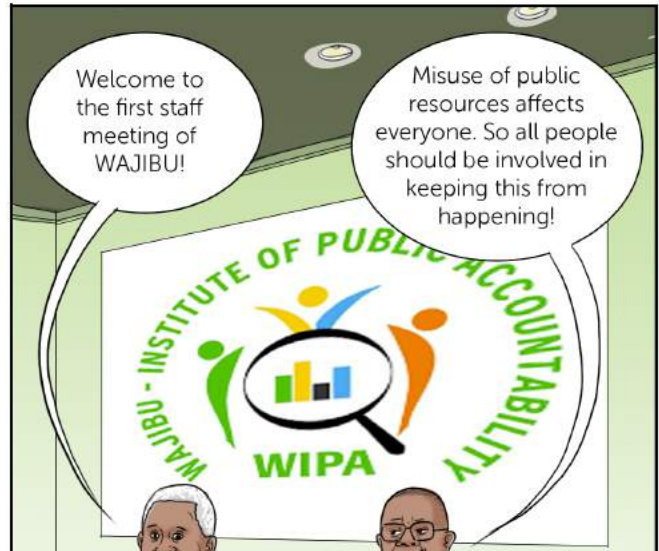
## On the road to accountability in Tanzania

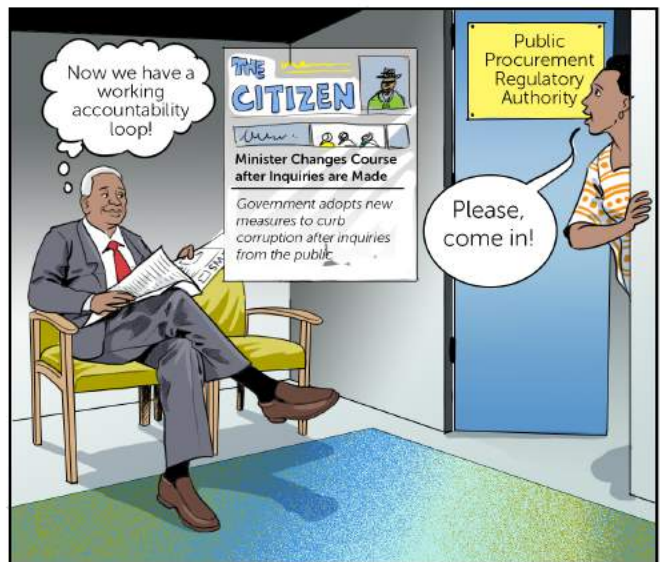
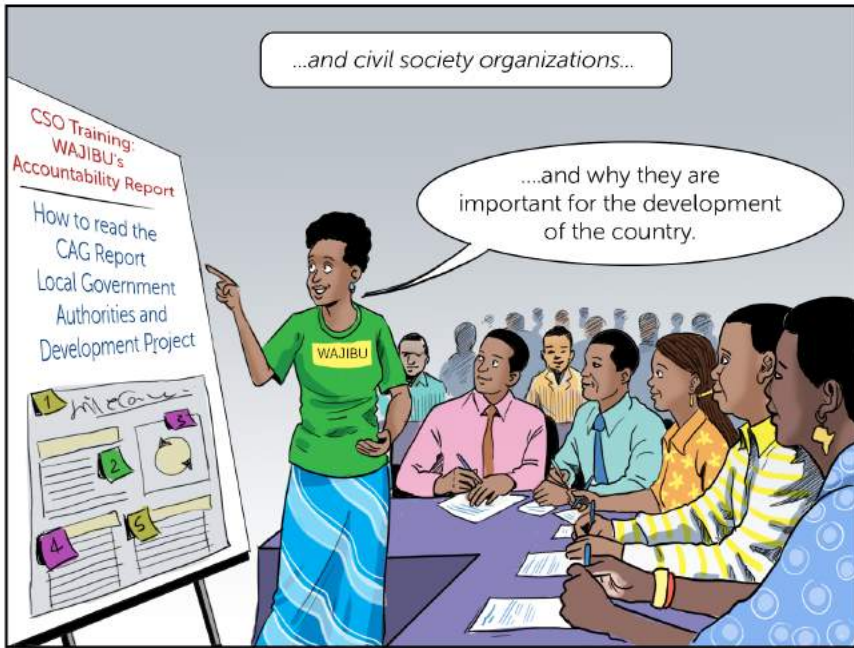
