1. Overview of the Organization

Hivos is an international development organization guided by humanist values. Together with citizens and their organizations, we aim to contribute towards just, inclusive and life sustaining societies where people have equal access to opportunities, rights and resources.

Hivos firmly believes in every person’s right to live in freedom and dignity, to enjoy equal opportunities, and to influence decisions made regarding the changes they want to see in their lives, communities and country.

Hivos focuses on supporting civil society organizations and networks; informal groups; independent media and cultural actors; human rights defenders; community organizations, and other organized civil society actors that form vital networks to improve their societies.

2. Project Context and Background

The Regional Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR) Fund is a regional funding mechanism that was set up in 2010 by Hivos Southern Africa and Ford Foundation to strengthen SRHR work in the region. The Fund was established in recognition of the critical need for a strategic regional response to collectively address the myriad of SRHR issues in Southern and East Africa (ESA) with particular attention to young people and adolescents as well as to provide an opportunity for donors to coordinate their support to SRHR in the region. In 2017, Hivos with support from Sida’s Africa Department Unit for Regional SRHR extended the scope and reach of the Fund to cover ESA.

The Fund is currently implementing the second phase of the project titled “Adolescent and Youth SRHR Inclusive Access Initiative” from March 2023 to December 2026. The new phase of the Fund focuses on strengthening and empowering youth and youth led organizations to increasingly defend and promote their SRHR, engage and influence duty bearers to increasingly design, adopt and implement laws and practices that promote the SRHR of adolescents and young people and finally to strengthen and empower youth researchers to generate evidence on SRHR in the ESA region.

The current Regional SRHR Fund key activities include sub-granting, coordination of key actors, convenings, building capacity, gathering and sharing information on advocacy and related SRHR issues to strengthen the efforts of civil society organizations (CSOs) working on SRHR in the ESA region. With the Fund now in its final year of implementation, Hivos invites applications from consultants who meet the following qualifications, competencies, and requirements:

- The consultant should have relevant academic qualifications at master’s degree level or higher in (i.e. Demography, Economics, Social Sciences, Statistics, Public Health etc.)
- Consultant should have proven experience and expertise in both quantitative and qualitative methods and proven experience of successfully undertaking project baseline, midline or endline program evaluations.
- The consultant should have proven experience of conducting similar set-up, size and scope of work in East and Southern Africa
- Knowledge and experience of participatory assessment / development approaches will be required.
- Knowledge and experience in organizational development approaches including organizational capacity assessment and development.
- Broad experience in conducting fieldwork (data collection, validation, entry, analysis, and report writing)
- Experience in leading teams implementing surveys in the field (training, field logistics, human relations, teamwork)
- Experience in SRHR programming and its related fields required.
- Provide a list of staff that will be involved in the evaluation – from the lead consultant, data analyst etc. to field researchers – with a summary of their relevant experience and proposed role in the evaluation.
- Experience in regional evaluation of programs on health and advocacy is an asset.
- A full CV for each team member should be provided as an annex.

3. The Scope of the tender is as follows:

Tenders are invited and should be emailed to proposals.hubsaf@hivos.org clearly labelled “Regional RSRHR Fund Endline Evaluation”. Submissions should meet ALL requirements. A Tender submitted for selected parts of the works only or which is incomplete will not be considered.

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6. Tender Clarifications

Should any Tenderer have questions to ask or have any doubt about the meaning of the Tender Documents, they should refer them in writing (which will be deemed to be by e-mail on proposals.hubsaf@hivos.org not later than the 17 August 2026. Questions submitted will be issued, together with answers, to all Tenderers. The questions and answers as issued will give no indication of which Tenderer raised the questions. Questions and answers will not form part of the Tender or the Contract. If, arising from a question, it is necessary to vary the individual Tender Documents, then an Addendum will be issued in accordance with the above procedure.

If for any reason during the Tender period it becomes necessary to vary the Tender Documents, an Addendum will be issued to all Tenderers.

Note that:

- ❖ Hivos may request further information from Tenderers after the submission of their proposal. Any additional information must be provided within five working days.
- ❖ The onus is on the contractor to ensure that their offer is complete and meets Hivos' requirements. Failure to comply may lead to the offer being rejected without any reason being given. Therefore, please ensure that you read this document carefully and answer all questions in full.

7. Participation

- This is an open tender, Hivos invites proposals from individuals and consultants/firm that are legally registered/established in their state of origin and are entitled to perform the obligations of such contracts or engagements.
- To be eligible for participation in this tender procedure, tenderers must prove to the satisfaction of Hivos that they comply with the necessary legal, technical, and financial requirements and have the ability to carry out the contract effectively.
- Any attempt by the tenderer to obtain confidential information, enter into unlawful agreements with competitors or influence the evaluation committee or Hivos during the process of examining, clarifying, evaluating and comparing tenders will lead to one or more of the following; disqualification in this tender, rejection of its offer(s)/bid, or legal consequences, or debarred from future tenders/procurements where applicable.
- Tenderers must at all times act loyally and impartially in accordance with the code of conduct of their profession. They must refrain from making public statements about the project or services without Hivos' prior written approval. They may not commit Hivos in any way without prior written consent.
- Tenderers and their staff are obliged to maintain professional secrecy; all reports, documents and information provided by Hivos are confidential and should be treated as such.

Hivos, at its sole discretion, will select the winners of this tender. To award the tender Hivos shall consider/perform administrative compliance checks to ensure that all requested information has been submitted.

Applications will be evaluated using a weighted scoring approach, as specified below:

Relevant expertise, experience, previous work done, understanding of the issues and ability to collaborate productively in an international setting
